Advance Directive will be on Thursday, June 27 starting at 1 p.m. in the RRC. During an emergency or at the end of life, you may face questions about medical treatment and not be able to answer them. You may assume your loved ones know what you would want, but that's not always true. Sheila Johnson from Fairview Health will be at the RRC to teach us more about this legal document.
