Fix-It Clinic Set for Saturday, May 18

Farmington, Minn., May 7, 2024 – Dakota County in coordination with the City of Farmington will host a Fix-It Clinic from 10 am to 1 pm at the Farmington Library, 508 Third St.

Bring your broken items for free repair help! Dakota County residents can get help repairing household items, clothes, electronics and more at a Fix-It Clinic. These monthly events help keep items out of landfills and empower people to repair things on their own. The event is free, and you do not need to register to participate. Helpful volunteers will guide you through each step, from troubleshooting to a completed repair. Bring up to three items that need fixing or mending such as lamps, vacuum cleaners, and clothes. You must be able to carry items into the clinic, so no overly large items. Bring any tools and supplies you think might help with the job, but it is not required to bring any tools. Partially funded by Dakota County and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency. There is no cost associated and participants do not need to pre-register.

Bring your problem-solving skills as a fixer or mender to a Fix-It Clinic. Volunteer fixers who have skills in soldering, electronics repair, electrical repair, sewing, woodworking and general tinkering are essential to making the clinics successful.
