



# City of Farmington 2026 Fee Schedule

Adopted by the Farmington City Council December 15, 2025

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### General Personnel Charges

When the City charges for Staff time, the hourly rate will be multiplied by a factor of 1.5, which includes salary and benefits. Specific rates are available from the Finance Department upon request.

### Escrow Deposits

Escrows are set to recover costs incurred by the City related to some permitting actions. Escrows shall be determined as defined in this Fee Schedule and may include, but are not limited to, administrative costs, personnel charges, and outside services. When the City requires an escrow, the amount represents initial deposits, not actual charges. Additional deposits may be required if costs incurred go above the original escrow amount. Any unused escrow will be returned to the applicant. An Escrow Deposit Agreement may be required.
