Farmington West Draft Alternative Urban Areawide Review available for public comment

FARMINGTON, Minn. – The City of Farmington has prepared a Draft Alternative Urban Areawide Review (AUAR) to understand the environmental implications of a future development of a 329-acre area consisting of six parcels located north of Richard J. Ames Mem Hwy (MN-50), bordered on the west by Flagstaff Avenue and to the east by Pilot Knob Road. Two development scenarios are proposed for evaluation in the AUAR:

Development Scenario 1: Development Scenario 1 includes multiple buildings for a total of 3 million square feet of a proposed technology park development.

Development Scenario 2: Development Scenario 2 includes multiple buildings for a total of 2,968,000 square feet of light industrial development.
