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City of Farmington is looking for Farm Land Lease Proposals

Farmington, Minn., Sept. 5, 2023 – The City of Farmington is accepting lease proposals to farm undeveloped park land located at the northeast corner of 195th Street West and Diamond Path.

“The city’s current lease expires on March 31, 2024 and it has begun the process of receiving proposals from interested parties to enter into a new five year lease agreement to farm undeveloped park land located in Jim Bell Park and Preserve,” said Parks and Recreation Director Kellee Omlid.

The size of the parcel to be farmed is 31.5 acres and will be leased for five years. Proposals are due at the Parks and Recreation office, 430 Third St., on or before 11 a.m. Oct. 6, 2023.

The rental shall be subject to the terms specified in the City’s Farm Lease Agreement. Interested parties desiring a copy of the Farm Lease Agreement Form may obtain it from the city’s website at FarmingtonMN.gov or from City Hall located at 430 Third Street, Farmington, Minnesota, 55024.

All proposals must be sealed. Proposals should be submitted as an annual rental price per acres. Proposals must be submitted on the city’s 5 Year Farm Lease Bid Submittal Form, which can be found on the city’s website. A map showing the location of the site to be leased for farming can also be found on the city’s website.
